Out of the 17 Goals, **Goal No. 3 clearly stated that Ensure Healthy Lives and Promote Well Being for all at all Stages and Target 3.7 clearly stated that By 2030, Ensure Universal access to sexual and reproductive health care services, including for Family Planning, information and education, and the integration of reproductive health into national strategies and programmes.**

We all know that India was the first Country in the World to have launched a National Programme for Family Planning in 1952. Over the decades, the programme has undergone transformation in terms of policy and actual programme implementation and currently being repositioned to not only achieve population stabilization goals but also promote reproductive health and reduce maternal, infant & child mortality and morbidity. Under the Programme public health sector provides various family planning services at various levels of health system.

Vasectomy is a surgical procedure for male [sterilization](#) or permanent [contraception](#). During the procedure, the male [vasa deferentia](#) are cut and tied or sealed so as to prevent [sperm](#) from entering into the [urethra](#) and thereby prevent [fertilization](#) of a female through [sexual intercourse](#). Vasectomies are usually performed in a physician's office, medical clinic, or, when performed on an animal, in a veterinary clinic—hospitalization is not normally required as the procedure is not complicated, the incisions are small, and the necessary equipment routine.

Road Safety is a multi-sectoral and multi-dimensional subject. It includes orderly development and management of roads, provisions of safer vehicles, and a comprehensive response to accidents. It relies on modern traffic management system and practices, improved safety standards in design, construction, operation and maintenance of roads, and production and maintenance of safer vehicles. Owing to unsafe condition on roads, the rate of accidents in India has been high. According to the WHO statistics for 2018, out of about 11.8 Lacs road accident deaths across the world, 84674 deaths were reported from India along. In the year 2018, the number of road accident death in India increased to 92618. The social cost of road accidents in India at about 3 percent of GDP. Considering the gravity of the situation, there is consensus that concerted measures are necessary for reducing this high level of accident death and injuries through improved safety measures and traffic management. In India, with the expansion in road network, motorization and urbanization in the country, the number of road accidents have surged. Road traffic injuries (RTIs) and fatalities have emerged as a major public health concern. With RTIs is having become one of the leading causes of deaths, disabilities and hospitalization which improve severe socio economic costs across the world.

Road safety is an issue of national concern, considering its magnitude and gravity and the consequent negative impact on the economy, public health and the general welfare of the people. Today, RTIs are on the leading causes of deaths, disabilities and hospitalization, with severe socio economic costs, across the world. World Health Statistics 2008 cited in Global Status Report on Road Safety states that RTIs in 2004 were the 9th leading cause of death and at current rates by 2030 are expected to be the 5th leading cause of death.

At present, Road Safety is a national priority which aimed at raising public awareness about traffic rules and ultimately to reduce casualties due to road accidents. Millions lose their life and millions get injured in road accidents globally; mainly due to lack of awareness about traffic rules or a behavior of flouting them. Therefore, to make people more aware of the traffic rules and to persuade them to follow rules while on road.

The main cause for the road accidents is attributed to be behavioral; that is a habitual flouting of traffic rules like not wearing helmet, not wearing seat belt, jumping traffic lights, over speeding, drunken driving etc. It is therefore needed that people are made aware of the perils of not following traffic rules, and the emotional and financial trauma that it could bring to their families.

Considering the gravity of this situation, **Bhartiya Lok Kalyan Sansthan (BLKS)** team with association with **Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, Govt. of India** and **Dept. of Transport, Govt. of Jharkhand** has intervened by participating and conducting **Road Safety Advocacy Campaign, 32nd National Road Safety Month 2021 on the Theme of “Good Samaritans”** in **Ranchi, Lohardaga, Gumla and Simdega** Districts of Jharkhand State from dated **18/01/2021 to 31/03/2021**. BLKS designed a different types of activities plan and conducted these by getting participation of Transport Department, Govt. of Jharkhand, Authorities from various Govt. Jharkhand leads the country in cases of witch-hunting, the data showed. This is the practice of first branding women as ‘witches’ and then punishing them with violence, often fatally. Since 2014, 173 people have been killed in Jharkhand after being labelled as witches, data showed. In 2017, 19 of the 73 (26%) people killed across India on suspicion of practising witchcraft were in Jharkhand, [NCRB data](#) reported.

In 2018, Jharkhand saw 18 of the total 63 ‘witchcraft’ deaths reported across the country, nearly one-third of all deaths. It was followed by Madhya Pradesh, a state with [more than double](#) its population, which recorded 10 deaths. Police officials, speaking informally to **India Spend**, blamed these attacks on the state’s [poor literacy rates](#)--70.3% as against the national average of 75.4%--and the belief in black magic.

But there is another reason, we found in our investigations across Jharkhand’s Ranchi and Gumla districts--the crippling shortage of quality, accessible healthcare in a predominantly rural state. Up to [75.95%](#) of the state’s people live in the countryside. Since public health facilities are situated in distant towns and transport facilities are limited, people in distress find it easier to seek help from quacks and *ojhas*.

Poor healthcare, low literacy and deeply entrenched beliefs in the healing power of the *ojhas*--these are the reasons why Jharkhand continues to report a high number of witch-hunt deaths, we learned from speaking with villagers, law enforcement officers and NGO workers.
